Year 6 had an amazing trip to PK Porthcurno - the museum of global communications. They started the day investigating how communication has changed over time, trying morse code machines and exploring how communication technology has shifted from telegraphs to text messages. They then entered the WW2 bunkers to see how they protected communications during the War and exploring how, even now, 97% of internet signal travels through cables.



Throughout the day they were asking their topic question - how did war change Cornwall? The tunnels gave them a very practical answer!

Year 4 Trip

On Tuesday 18th January, Year 4 went on a class trip to St Ives to learn about the local sculptor Barbara Hepworth. Whilst at the Barbara Hepworth Museum, the children listened intently, ask questions and were very respectful of their surroundings. The children were also given the opportunity to have a go at sketching some of the sculptures. Their behaviour was phenomenal.

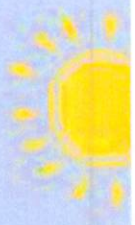

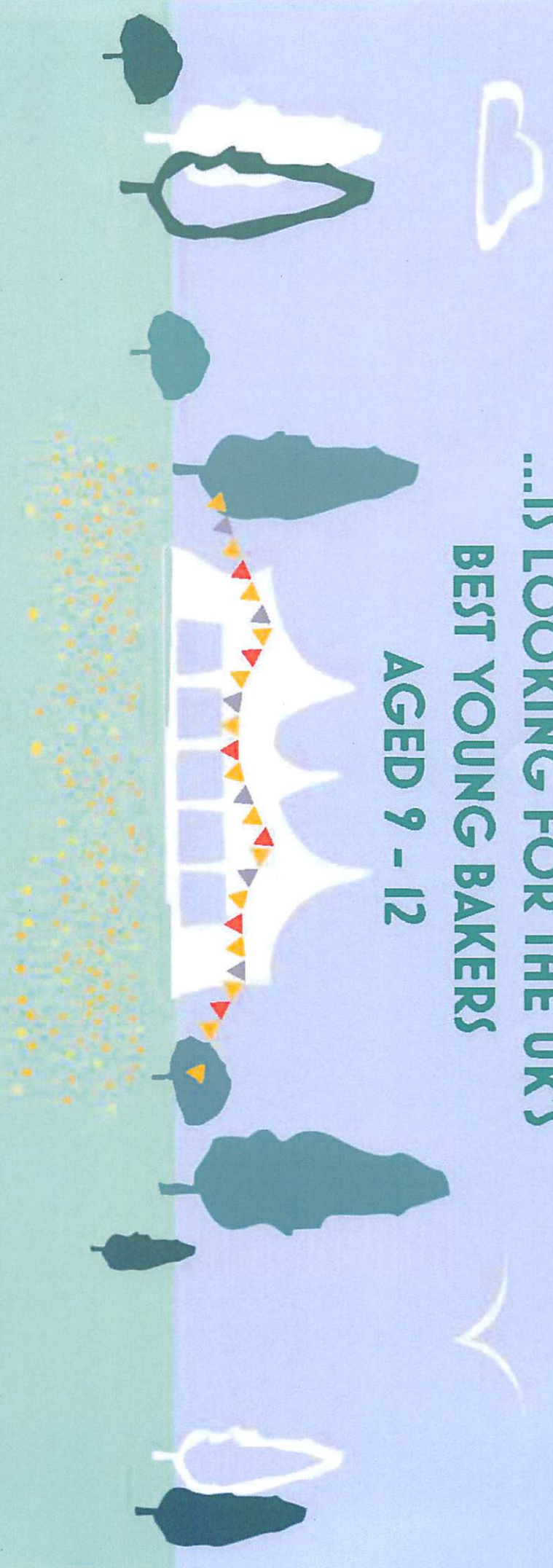
